## Fun with words – Meanings in Context

**band** = a group

**bound** = springing upwards and forwards

**hind** = located near the rear of an animal

**joey** = a young kangaroo

**limbs** = external parts of the body, such as arms and legs

**pouch** = bag-like structure on the belly of the mother Kangaroo, where her baby lives till it grows up

**travelling** = taking a journey or trip
