Q 1. Where are you likely to see this Lion in its natural habitat?

A 1. You are likely to see this Lion on the grassy African plain. (Lions are also found in India.)

Q 2. With whom are you likely to see the Lion cub?

A 2. You are likely to see the Lion cub with its mother or its father.

Q 3. Can you name one physical feature of the Lion cub's father?

Q 3. The Lion cub's father has a huge mane.

Q 4. What is a group of Lions called?

A 4. A group of Lions is called a pride.

Q 5. Name three things the Lioness teaches the Lion cub?

A 5. The Lioness teaches the Lion cub to hunt, to avoid the Porcupine, and to choose the prey it wants and make sure that it gets it.

Q 6. Who do the Lion cub and its parents live with?

A 6. The Lion cub and its parents live with the mother Lioness' sisters and their cubs.

Q 7. What does the Lion cub's father do?

A 7. The Lion cub's father roars and defends the pride's space.

Q 8. Who are the good hunters in the pride of Lions?

A 8. The Lioness and her sisters are the good hunters in the pride of Lions.

Q 9. What does the Lion family do after the Lionesses finish hunting?

A 9. After the Lionesses finish hunting, the lion family eats their fill, till the next hunt, on another day.

Q 10. What can the Lion cub do with its mouth and sharp teeth?

A 10. The Lion cub can roar fiercely with its mouth and bite with its sharp teeth.

Fun with words – Meanings in Context

fiercely = strongly and forcefully

mane = long hair growing around an animal's head and neck

prey = intended victim of an attack, or animal hunted for food

pride = family group of lions

safari = a journey in Africa, usually to see wildlife

snoozing = sleeping or dozing
