Q 1. Where can you see the Giant Panda in its natural habitat?

A 1. You can see the Giant Panda in a forest in China.

Q 2. What does the Giant Panda look like?

A 2. The Giant Panda looks like a big teddy bear.

Q 3. Can you describe the coat of the Giant Panda?

A 3. The Giant Panda's coat is thick, furry, and creamy white and black in colour.

Q 4. Which parts of the Giant Panda's coat are black in colour?

A 4. The Giant Panda's arms, legs, ears, eye patches and a band on its upper back are black in colour.

Q 5. How tall can the Giant Panda grow and how much can it weigh?

A 5. The Giant Panda can grow up to five feet tall and weigh up to a hundred kilos.

Q 6. What is the Giant Panda nimble at and where is it clumsy?

A 6. The Giant Panda is a nimble tree climber but has a clumsy gait on the ground.

Q 7. How does the Giant Panda spend most of its time?

A 7. The Giant Panda spends most of its time seeking bamboo plants to munch and chewing away throughout the day.

Q 8. Which parts of a Giant Panda's body help it to eat bamboo?

A 8. The Giant Panda's big broad teeth and thumb help it to eat bamboo.

Q 9. What does the Giant Panda find?

A 9. The Giant Panda finds its friends and space growing scarce.

Q 10. What does the Giant Panda hope for?

A 10. The Giant Panda hopes there will always be enough bamboo forests and enough Giant Pandas to eat them.

Fun with words – Meanings in Context

extremely = very much, to a high degree

gait = way of moving, walking or running

nimble = able to move quickly and lightly

scarce = becoming fewer in number and hard to find

seeking = searching for something
