A 1. You can see the Uakari in South America, along the River Amazon.
- Q 2. Where is the Uakari likely to be?
A 2. The Uakari is likely to be high up on a tree.
- Q 3. Where does the Uakari live?
A 3. The Uakari lives up in the leafy canopy of rainforest trees so tall.
- Q 4. How does the Uakari move about in the trees?
A 4. The Uakari is a nimble climber, and can easily move about in the trees.
- Q 5. What kind of animal is the Uakari?
A 5. The Uakari is a kind of monkey.
- Q 6. What do the Uakari and its cousins look like?
A 6. The Uakari has a pink face and whitish fur. Its cousins are red or brown in colour.
- Q 7. How does the Uakari spend its days?
A 7. The Uakari spends its days looking for food, up on branches or down on the ground.
- Q 8. Who does the Uakari live with?
A 8. The Uakari lives with its family group.
- Q 9. What is the Uakari's favorite meal?
A 9. The Uakari's favorite meal is fruit and leaves.
- Q 10. What do the Uakari and its family do when people come by?
A 10. The Uakari and its family are rather shy and hide when people come by.
- Q 10. What does the Uakari do when it is dark?
A 10. When it is dark the Uakari finds its leafy nest, where it can sleep till it is day.

Fun with words – Meanings in Context

- canopy** = a covering that provides shelter from the heat and rain, also refers to tall trees growing close together so their branches provide shelter
- favourite** = most liked
- if the coast is clear** = if the surrounding area looks safe
- mighty** = large and strong
- rainforest** = a forest in areas of heavy rainfall, and home to many different creatures
