A 9. The Zebra migrates in search of fresh food and water.

Q 10. Where can the Zebra be seen after the rains?

A 10. After the rains the Zebra can be seen grazing in the grasslands in its striped and rain-washed hide.

Fun with words – Meanings in Context

camouflage = device that helps a creature hide by making it hard to see among its surroundings, such as the pattern on its skin or the colour of its feathers matching its environment

gallop = the fast running pace of a horse or similar animal

grazing = feeding like cattle in a field

kith and kin = friends and relatives

migrate = travel from one place to another
